The Sunday after Easter was established as Divine Mercy Sunday officially on April 30, 2000 when Blessed Maria Faustina Kowalska was canonized. St. Faustina's journey began long before when a peasant Polish girl entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. St. Faustina experienced many emotions during her mission to share the message of Our Lord's Divine Mercy to the whole world.

“The Lord said, ‘...Today I am sending you with My mercy to the people of the whole world. I do not want to punish aching mankind, but I desire to heal it, pressing it to My Merciful Heart. ... (Diary, 1588), ...You are the secretary of My mercy. I have chosen you for that office in this life and the next life. ... (Diary, 1605) ...to make known to souls the great mercy I have for them and to exhort them to trust in My bottomless mercy. (Diary 1567)’ ”

We too can follow this mission and help St. Faustina bring souls to Our Lord. The Divine Mercy Message is spelled out as simple as ABC as listed on the National Shrine of The Divine Mercy website.

A - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

B - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

C - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received by our trust. The more we open the door of our hearts and lives to Him with trust, the more we can receive.

Hopefully everyone can experience the joy of participating in Divine Mercy events this Sunday. We can also carry this message throughout the year by any or all of these daily activities:

- Venerating the Divine Mercy Image, on a prayer card, screen saver, or downloaded picture.
- Saying the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3pm each day or anytime during the day.
- Evoking the phrase, Jesus, I Trust in You, out of love, mercy or for help.

There are many beautiful resources available to guide everyone on the journey of God's Great Mercy!
