Pastor's Report (Monsignor Dempsey):

- Current practices and policies: Archdiocese have allowed masses and other activities to continue with new rules and guidelines.
 - Masses: There are three masses, Saturday night and Sunday 10AM and 11:45AM.
 Saturday and Sunday's 10AM masses are usually at capacity of 100. The 11:45
 AM mass is light in attendance at about 40-50. Daily masses are held Monday through Friday with about 40-50 people in attendance which is close to pre-COVID levels.
 - There have been 5 or 6 funerals this month. All are in larger Church as the capacity for that church is up to 100.
 - A few weddings have been scheduled.
 - There were 20 candidates confirmed on September 20th. Another confirmation is scheduled for next with 13 to 14 candidates expected to receive the sacrament.
 - Three baptisms were conducted.
 - Confirmation has been scheduled for next year. The new vicar will be celebrating the confirmation.
- Religious Education plans Per the Archdiocese guidelines religious education will have one
 day of in person teaching and then three remotely. First classes started week on September
 21. There has been a difficult time attracting catechist to teach.
- Current financial status: Most churches in the area are down around 20% from their budgeted amounts. St Patrick is performing slightly better down around 13% from budget.

Renew My Church:

• Nine parishes in Lake Co are in Wave 6 of the program. It does not seem that this plan will change much.
