A Letter from Fr. Patrick Kizza

October 5, 2025

Respect Life Month: *"...Each of us is willed, each of us is loved, each of us is Necessary"*

Dear brothers and sisters; In his first address to the Diplomatic Corps of the Holy See, Pope Leo XIV reminded the world: *"... no one is exempted from striving to ensure respect for the dignity of every person, especially the most frail and vulnerable, from the unborn to the elderly, from the sick to the unemployed, citizens and immigrants alike."* These words echo the very heart of the Gospel and resound with urgency in our own time.

Every October, the Catholic Church in the United States observes **Respect Life Month**, beginning with Respect Life Sunday. It is a sacred moment to renew our unwavering commitment to the dignity of every human life from conception to natural death. **This year's theme, "Life: Our Sign of Hope," flows beautifully from the Jubilee Year of Hope, inviting us to be the light in the darkness and witnesses to God's promise, that His vision of life, love and "hope will not disappoint" (Romans 5:5).**

Our longing for hope is depicted in the prophet Habakkuk who is speaking to us today: *"How long, O Lord? I cry for help, but you do not listen! I cry out to you, 'Violence!' but you do not intervene."* He decried the breakdown of society of Judah and why God seemed to permit it. Even in our time we cry like Habakkuk; violence and strife, abortion, assisted suicide, capital punishment, gun violence, poverty, war, and the mistreatment of the vulnerable. Yet Habbakkuk did not just complain but rather he engaged directly with honest cry to God; *"How long, O Lord? Like in his time, the Lord assures us: that the righteous will live by their faith in His plan "...will not disappoint, if it delays, wait for it, it will surely come, it will not be late."* Our faith anchors us in this promise: even in hardships, life remains God's greatest gift, and faith itself, grounded in the encounter with Christ and supported by hope, provides the authentic meaning of life and allows believers to face life's difficulties with secure trust in God's promises. *"If you have faith the size of a mustard seed... it would obey you.* This is the power; that even a tiny amount of true faith Jesus says can accomplish great things.

In the same faith, Christ invites us to pray as we decry like Habbakkuk against the injustices in our society today. May this Respect Life Month, be a time of interceding that all those involved in all sorts of injustices may heed to God's Voice *"If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts., (Psalm 95),* Let us pray for the world to see life as a sign of hope as willed by God. As Benedict XVI taught us *"Each of us is the result of a thought of God. Each of us is willed, each of us is loved, each of us is Necessary"*.

Dear Friends,

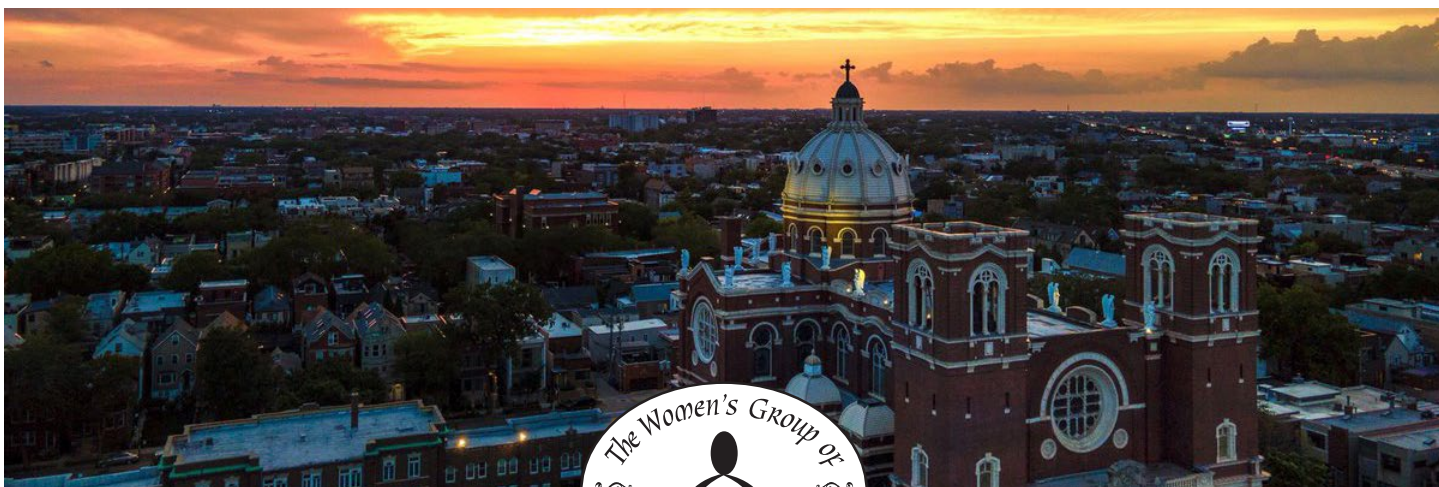

Ministry of Care at St. Patrick Church

The Ministry of Care at St. Patrick Church is a vital expression of our parish mission to bring Christ's presence to those who cannot join us at Mass. Rooted in Jesus' words, "*I was sick and you visited me*" (Matthew 25:36), this ministry ensures that our homebound, hospitalized, and senior parishioners remain closely connected to their faith community.

Currently, 24 parishioners serve as Ministers of Care, though the number fluctuates throughout the year as some members are temporarily unable to serve and others travel during the winter months. Our ministers faithfully reach out across the communities of Lake Forest, Lake Bluff, and Lincolnshire.

Our ministers regularly visit Lake Forest Place, the Sheridan, and Green Oaks senior communities, serving between 40–50 residents each week through individual visits or Eucharistic services. We also serve Balmoral Rehabilitation Facility and bring Communion to homebound parishioners. Altogether, the Ministry of Care brings Communion to 50–65 people each month.

At the same time, there are facilities that we cannot serve. Neither St. Patrick nor St. Mary currently has enough ministers available to cover all the senior communities in our area. With more volunteers, we could extend Christ's presence to these communities as well.

This ministry not only nourishes those we visit but also enriches the spiritual lives of our ministers, who find joy and grace in these encounters. If you feel called to serve as a Minister of Care, we would love to welcome you. Your "yes" could make it possible to bring Christ's love to even more of our neighbors. 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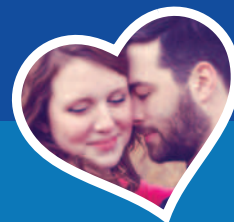
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
