### Pastors Report (Monsignor):

- Extended Eucharistic adoration will be held on Nov. 1, using a monstrance blessed by St. John Paul II.
- 11/1 All Saints day Friday, Mass at 8:00am & 6:30pm
- October count for attendance across the Diocese is lower than anticipated; 2018 numbers are 4% less than 2017
- Donations at St. Pat's are down 13% YTD vs. Budget
  - Commentary that some donors have died or moved away potentially attributing to lower funds
- Renew My Church is in third wave out of 5/6 waves; many Lake County parishes are in the later waves.
- New lighting system in the church
- New downspouts needed around Church. Will be replaced in next 1-2 months.

#### Old Business:

- Database of Parishioners' Emails Moved discussion to Nov. Meeting when Tom & Tim can attend. Jennifer assessing PDS capabilities and status/timing of database that makes sense for the church; continue to research to meet capabilities. Working with Tom on opportunities to move to Cloud-based system for PDS soon b/c discounts available.
- Ministry Fair Outstanding job to Heidi and Jennifer!!! Very well done and positively received!
  - Outcome exceeded Heidi's expectation
  - o Approx. 67 people signed up to help volunteer in various Ministries
  - o Great atmosphere
  - o Thanks to Monsignor for his support and Homily at each Mass
  - Next Steps: \*\* Follow-Up is critical! Only half of the Ministries have followed-up with new volunteers. \*\*\*
  - o Lessons:
    - Planning is critical
    - Coordinating with Parish Staff Member was very valuable (thanks, Jennifer!)

- Need guidelines so back-up ministry support is in place
- Posters & Brochures were helpful and can be used for future Ministry Fairs
- Ministry Leaders have varying degrees of engagement
- Transitioning of Ministry Leadership is needed
- \*\*Suggestion to have card in pew for parishioners to get involved and offer feedback after Ministry Fair (in case they missed it)
- o Propose: Hold Ministry Fair every 2 years,
  - Need 2 Coordinators
  - Re-use posters & brochures

#### **New Business:**

- Transitioning ministries will be a future topic to explore/brainstorm
- PPC Guidelines/By-Laws Sub-team will facilitate PPC charter recommendations starting at the end of October. Examples were shared; however, they were at the parish level, not PPC level
