

A Letter from Fr. Patrick Kizza

August 3, 2025

Dear Parishioner,

The psalmist writes, "If today you hear His voice, harden not your hearts." These words are more than poetic; they are a divine invitation. God is calling each one of us by name. He speaks to our hearts in quiet moments, in the Eucharist, in prayer, and through one another. The question is not whether God is calling, but whether we are ready to listen and to respond.




