

Reflection for February 1, 2026

Living the Beatitudes at Saint Patrick Parish


In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus proclaims the Beatitudes, a vision of life that turns worldly values upside down. Blessed are not the powerful or the successful by human standards, but the poor in spirit, the merciful, the peacemakers, and those who hunger for righteousness. The Beatitudes are not simply comforting words; they are a call to live differently. They invite us to trust God more than ourselves, to show compassion when it is difficult, and to remain faithful even when it costs us something. As Pope Francis often said, the Beatitudes are the "identity card of the Christian." They describe what a disciple of Jesus looks like in everyday life.

We see these Beatitudes lived out in the life of our parish. I am deeply grateful for the ministry of **Fr. Larry Hennessy**, who has served Saint Patrick Parish with a true pastor's heart. Through his kindness, presence, and faithful leadership, he has touched many lives and helped this community grow in faith. As he retires from Saint Patrick, let us continue to keep him in our prayers. 
