



Deacon De Frank to retire on Corpus Christi Sunday A love story based on Faith and the Eucharist

The story of how Deacon Frank De Frank met his wife Pat is notable. But it was his love story with our Faith and the Eucharist that would light up both of their lives—and ours as parishioners of St. Patrick.

Deacon Frank's preaching and community-building skills led to the establishment of two practices at St. Patrick: First Friday Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in 2010 and the Feast of Corpus Christi procession in 2020, both recognizing Christ's presence in the Eucharist. He also helped to create our Prayer Wall in 2009 as part of a committee dedicated to enhancing parishioners' prayer life.

"My primary focus has been on the Eucharist," said Frank. "My mother influenced my love for Jesus." Faith in God's providence is also a significant part of Frank's personal history.

After college and service in the Peace Corps, Frank returned to Chicago and spoke at a city parish about his overseas experience. His future wife Pat attended the presentation because she was interested in joining the Peace Corps. Upon meeting, Frank was smitten. They subsequently married, had two daughters, and will be celebrating their 60th wedding anniversary in July.

With a career move to an executive position in Bloomington, Minnesota, Frank and Pat dedicated themselves to their local parish's mission. The experience determined his calling. Frank enrolled in Saint Paul Seminary, being ordained as a Deacon in 2001.

To be closer to family, including their grown daughters, the couple moved to Lincolnshire, Illinois, where Frank resumed his Deacon duties, serving at Saint Mary of Vernon, Vernon Hills, Santa Maria del Popolo Church, Mundelein, and later St. Patrick in 2008.

Having served our parish for the past 17 years, Deacon Frank will retire and preach his last homily on the Feast of Corpus Christi Sunday, June 22, 2025, at the 11:45 Mass, followed by the procession at 12:45 pm, and a light luncheon in the O'Gara Center, honoring his contributions.

Once a Deacon, always a Deacon

As described in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (1570), "Deacons share in Christ's mission and grace in a special way. The sacrament of Holy Orders marks them with an imprint ('character') which cannot be removed, and which configures them to Christ, who made himself the 'deacon' or servant of all."

Deacon Frank plans to continue attending daily and weekend Masses and volunteering at WSFI, a local not-for-profit Catholic radio station, where you can listen live at 88.5 FM/750 AM. You can always stay in touch with Frank by calling the parish office.

The procession will end with Benediction in the main Church.


This will be followed by a retirement celebration for Deacon De Frank with a light lunch in the O'Gara Center.


