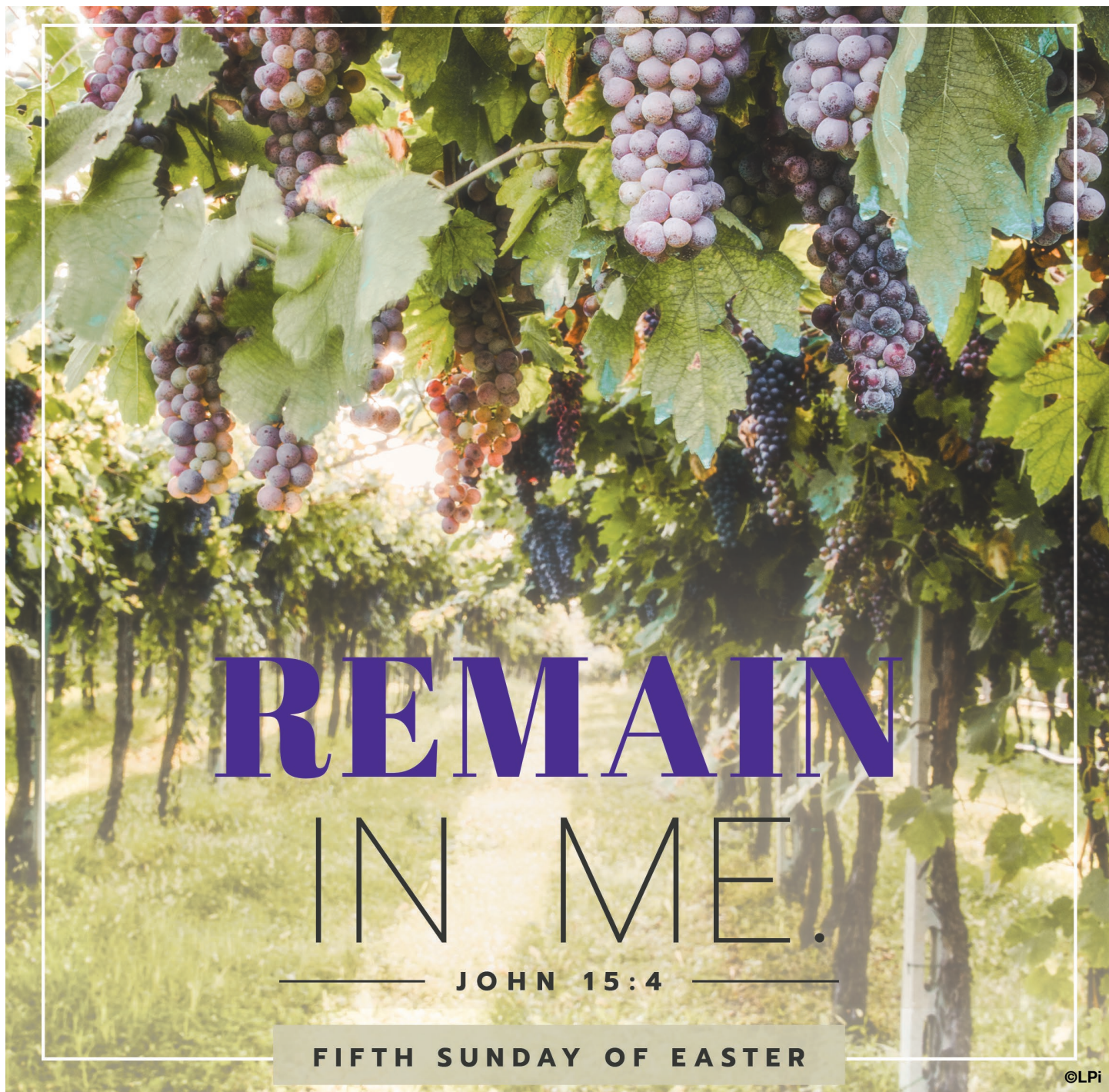

One of her most famous quotes, “Be who God meant you to be and you will set the world on fire,” is so prevalent for today. We all have the opportunity to evangelize. Focus, Fellowship of Catholic University Students, is a wonderful organization that works with college age students as well as parishes. They have 10 tips on how to evangelize:

1. Pray for people by name
2. Go out into the world
3. Be bold
4. Extend personal invitations
5. Share life; i.e. be with them on their turf
6. Share your story
7. Practice hospitality wherever you are
8. Share the Gospel with a specific invitation
9. Encounter Christ together
10. Teach others to do the same

Whichever season of life you find yourself, you could choose one or two of these tips and make a difference in someone's life. If your life circumstances allow, perhaps you may be able to attend the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage or the National Eucharistic Congress. You also, may be called to be a prayer warrior for Christ and offer prayer intentions and sacrifice, for the people you love, social issues or the general state of the world. 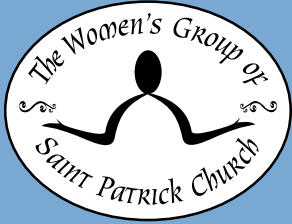

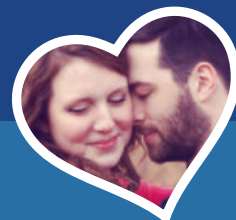
