



- 5. Share life; i.e. be with them on their turf
- 6. Share your story
- 7. Practice hospitality wherever you are
- 8. Share the Gospel with a specific invitation
- 9. Encounter Christ together

If your life circumstances allow, perhaps you may be able to attend the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage or the National Eucharistic Congress.
