## A Letter from Fr. Patrick Kizza

April 19, 2026

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Gospel of the journey to Emmaus (Luke 24:13–35) is a beautiful reminder that the Risen Lord walks with us even when we do not recognize Him. The two disciples were leaving Jerusalem discouraged and confused. They had hoped in Jesus, but the events of the cross had shattered their expectations. How often do we feel the same way in our daily lives? We experience disappointment—a failed plan, a broken relationship, or unanswered prayers—and we begin to walk away, thinking that God is no longer present. Yet, just like in the Gospel, Jesus draws near to us quietly, listening to our struggles and walking beside us, even when our eyes are blinded by sorrow or doubt.

In our everyday life, we can recognize this Emmaus experience. For example, when someone is going through a difficult time, losing a job, facing illness, or grieving a loved one, they may feel alone. But often, God sends people to accompany them: a friend who listens, a family member who offers support, or even a stranger who shows kindness. These moments are not coincidences; they are signs that Christ is walking with us. The turning point for the disciples came when Jesus broke the bread. Their eyes were opened, and they recognized Him. In the same way, we encounter Jesus most clearly in the Eucharist and in moments of love and service. What once seemed like an ordinary situation becomes a sacred encounter.

As we reflect on this Gospel, we also take a moment to express deep gratitude to the liturgy ministry and all the volunteers who organized Holy Week, Easter Sunday, and Divine Mercy Sunday so beautifully. Like the disciples who welcomed Jesus saying, “Stay with us,” you have helped create a space where Christ is welcomed, encountered, and recognized in the breaking of the bread. Your dedication allows our parish community to experience the presence of the Risen Lord in a meaningful way. May we all continue to invite Jesus into our daily journey, so that our hearts too may burn within us, and like the disciples, we may go out and share the Good News with joy.

**THE APPEALS OF OUR LADY**  
APPARITIONS AND MARIAN SHRINES IN THE WORLD

Imagined and implemented by Servant of God CARLO ACUTIS



Servant of God Carlo Acutis, as an expert catechist, had continually sought to find increasingly new ways to help others reinforce their faith. For this reason he bequeathed to us as an inheritance his Exhibitions, among which is the very notable one on **Eucharistic Miracles**. It was precisely in 2002, while visiting the expositions of the Meeting of Rimini, that Carlo had decided to organize an exhibition on the Eucharistic Miracles recognized by the Church. A demanding commitment in which even his family members were involved for nearly two and a half years. The spiritual effects being brought about by this Exhibition were unpredictable on the eve of the project. To this day we can affirm that the Exhibition has been hosted in all 5 Continents thanks to the generous contribution of several very special people, among whom stand out the members of the *Real Presence Eucharistic Education and Adoration Association* who assisted so very much in this undertaking.

Finally in 2014 we have succeeded in bringing also to completion this exhibition, dedicated to the **Virgin Mary**, which Carlo had initiated in 2006 but was unable to finish due to the sudden onset of a fulminating leukemia that brought him to Heaven within a few days. The young Servant of God Carlo Acutis was profoundly marked in his spiritual journey by the Virgin Mary, “*humble and high beyond any creature*” (Dante Alighieri), and he established from the inception the objective of imitating her in all of her virtues. The Virgin Mary was for him the highest example of purity and of unconditional love for God. Mary Most Holy revealed to mankind the image of that which the Church, a wanderer upon the earth, will be one day – at the end of this world. We know that for each Christian, holiness is achieved only through an intense life of Faith, Hope, and Charity. Of all three of these theological virtues, Carlo wrote that Mary “**is an exemplary model and**

**her example of faith, supported by her perfect charity, must encourage us to continue in our journey toward holiness regardless of our fragility.”**

Because of this, the motive is well understood that drove Carlo to be continually interested in all of the manifestations of the Virgin Mary which, for more than two millennia, like very bright stars, have illuminated the path for multitudes of people. “**Surely**,” Carlo said, “**the miracles accomplished by the Virgin Mary during her apparitions on earth can be of a great help to increase the Faith of many people... How can they be ignored**”, he often asked, “**the appeals that Our Lady gave us? And yet**”, he said, “**knowing our little Faith, in her maternal goodness, the Blessed Mother wanted to work countless numbers of miracles precisely to help us to believe, yet despite these amazing signs many, still today, remain so indifferent!**” Carlo used to say that “**many people seek signs from Heaven to reinforce their Faith, but there are also many who unfortunately do not even seek them and if by chance they find them, intentionally ignore them because they are too preoccupied with worldly things.**”

However, he never lost spirit, because he nourished in his heart the ever lively hope that, sooner or later, the Guardian Angels would have created favorable circumstances in order to sensitize souls that were distant from God to embark upon a life more consistent with His Laws. Our wish, like Carlo’s, is that through this exhibition many will rediscover the path which leads to God and that they, too, are able to become bearers of light to all those who are still in darkness.

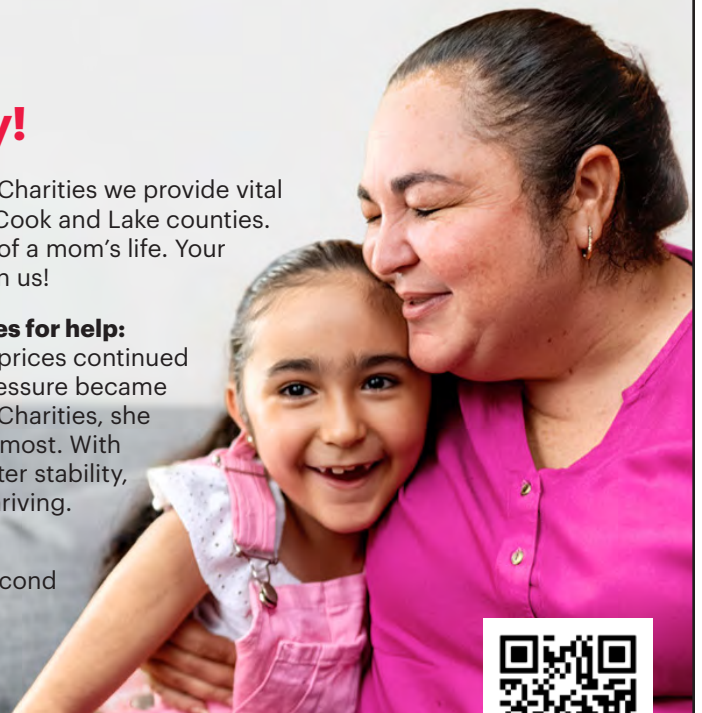
