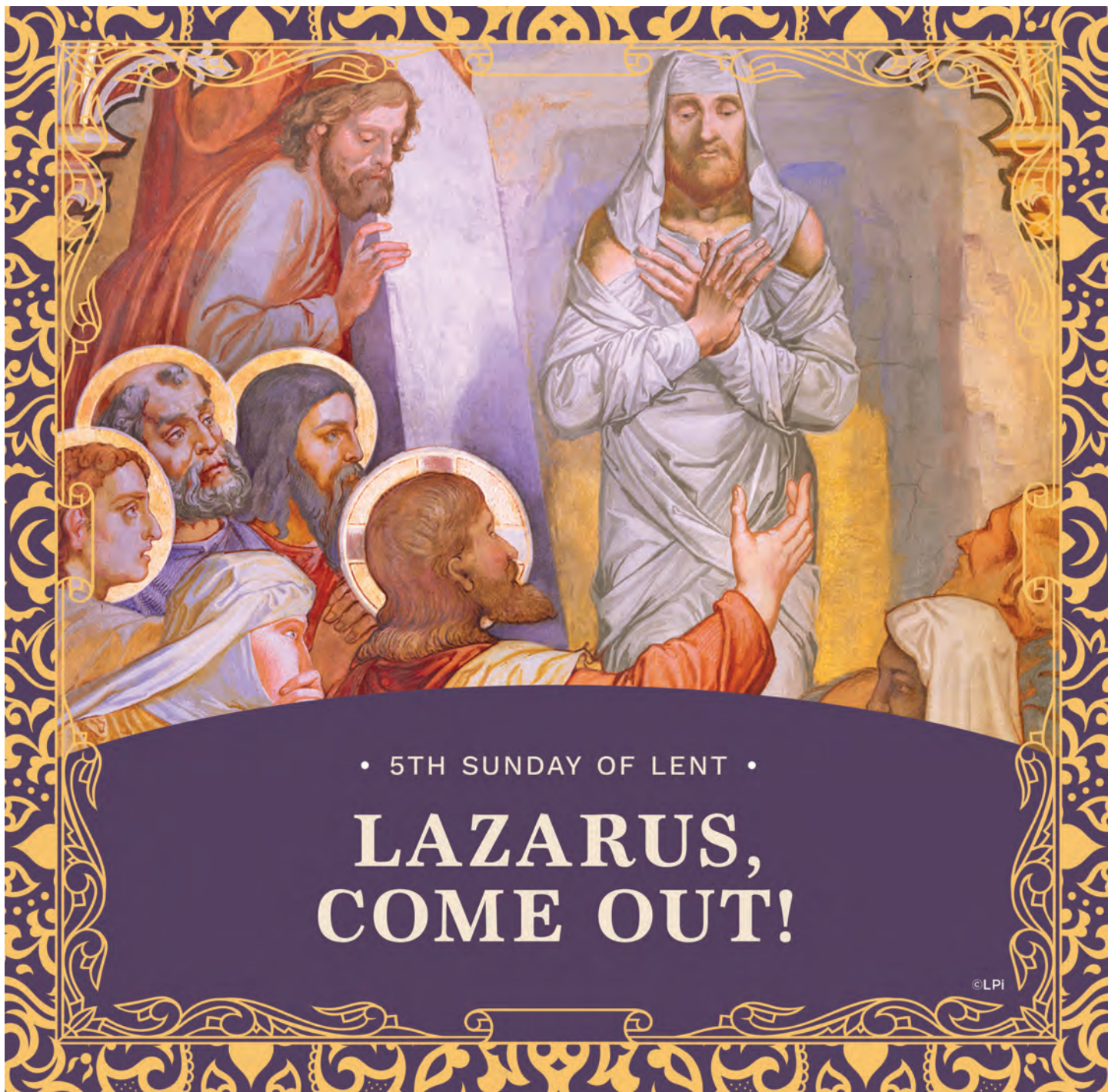

### TO TEACH WHO CHRIST IS

The To Teach Who Christ Is (TTWCI) capital campaign which formally ended several years ago, raised over \$2.4 million dollars and greatly blessed our parish. As you may recall, these funds allowed us to meet our campaign goal for the Archdiocese, install air conditioning and completely restore and refurbish the stained glass windows in the old church, remodel the O'Gara Activity Center, install new lighting in the main church and parking lots, and replace the roof on the 950 W. Everett building. The parish has \$234,626 left over from the TTWCI campaign.

In a few months, St. Patrick will begin its participation in a new capital campaign, Generation to Generation. Currently, we are working with campaign managers on a feasibility study to determine if the parish's fundraising potential is sufficient to engage in full-time campaign management services for six months. Having full-time management services will allow the parish to more effectively design our fundraising plan and strategies, manage and coordinate fundraising activities, analyze progress, provide training for staff and campaign volunteers, and assist in developing communications and campaign materials, to name a few of the benefits provided. The fees are \$297,500 for six months of services. The parish would like to use the left over TTWCI campaign monies to cover the majority of these fees. Any remaining fees will be covered by savings.

We are extremely grateful to all those who have been so very generous. Your sacrifices allowed us to upgrade our facilities in many ways and will allow us to address new needs. We cannot say "Thank You" enough.
